A LITTLE HISTORY

The Gowanda Central School District is located in the scenic village of Gowanda in rural Cattaraugus County. The village Gowanda – whose name is in Seneca means "almost surrounded by hills" or "a valley among the hills" – straddles Cattaraugus and Erie counties and is split by the Cattaraugus Creek. The Cattaraugus Reservation of the Seneca Nation borders the village. LOGISTICALLY SPEAKING

GCS is a Pre-Kindergarten through 12th grade district with approximately 1,200 students distributed equally across the Pre-K-4 Elementary School, the 5-8 Middle School and the 9-12 High School. The district maintains 2 educational campuses and 1 athletic field in the Town of Perrysburg and the Village of Gowanda. Students from Collins, North Collins, Gowanda, Hanover, Persia, Perrysburg, Dayton and the Cattaraugus Territory.

Performing arts, technology, home & careers, interscholastic athletics, student clubs and extracurricular activities enjoy strong participation in Gowanda. Voca-tional and Special Education services are provided by the Erie 2-Chautauqua-Cat-taraugus Board of Cooperative Education-al Services and Erie 1 BOCES.
